Frequent Flyers

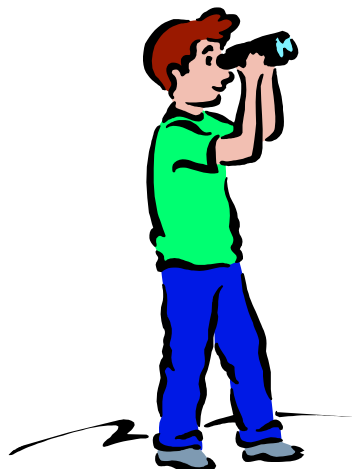
Twice a year birds migrate to places where there is more food and a warmer climate. Explore how scientists track migrating birds and the challenges birds face along the way.
